### II. PUBLIC CONTRACT

Subject-matter On May 29, 2025, a contract was concluded between the Contracting Authority and SAKO Brno, a.s., ID No.: 607 14 470, with its Registered Office at Jedovnická 4247/2, Židenice, 628 00 Brno, the subject of which is primarily the Contracting Authority's obligation to provide, for a specified period, the services of a construction manager in relation to the implementation of a public contract entitled "Modernization of the Waste-to-Energy Plant of SAKO Brno," ref. no. in the Public Procurement Bulletin Z2024-028031. The subject of this public contract is to ensure the activities of the Contracting Authority as a construction manager within the framework of the above-mentioned project, to the extent of a member of the construction manager's implementation team in the position of a specialist for energy recovery from waste.

A detailed description of the subject-matter is set out in the binding model contract forming Annex No. 4 to these procurement documents (hereinafter referred to as the "**contract**").

### III. TIME AND PLACE OF PERFORMANCE OF THE PUBLIC CONTRACT, MODEL CONTRACT, PAYMENT AND COMMERCIAL TERMS

**The time and place of performance** of the public contract is determined in the contract.

**The binding payment terms** are set out in the binding model contract.

### IV. COMMUNICATION

**The public contract is awarded entirely electronically using the certified electronic tool E-ZAK available at <https://zakazky.bkom.cz/>.**

All actions within this procurement procedure, as well as **all communication** between the contracting authority and the economic operator, shall be conducted electronically, in particular via the E-ZAK electronic tool.

All documents sent via the E-ZAK electronic tool shall be deemed to have been duly delivered on the date of their delivery to the addressee's user account in the E-ZAK electronic tool. The delivery of a document is not affected by whether the document has been read by its addressee or whether the E-ZAK electronic tool has sent a notification to the addressee's contact email address that a new message has been delivered to their user account in the E-ZAK electronic tool.

The economic operator is always responsible for familiarizing themselves with the documents sent by the contracting authority via the E-ZAK electronic tool in a proper and timely manner, as well as for the accuracy of the contact details provided by the economic operator.

The contracting authority hereby informs the economic operator that in order to make full use of all the features of the E-ZAK electronic tool, the economic operator or economic operator in the tender procedure is required to complete the registration process at <https://zakazky.bkom.cz/regitrace.html> in the Central Database of Economic operators (CDD) of the FEN.cz system at <https://fen.cz/#/registration>. The contracting authority also informs economic operators that registration is not immediate and is subject to approval by the system administrator, who has two working days to accept or reject the registration if the registration request does not contain all the required information.

### V. QUALIFICATION

Economic operators are required to demonstrate the following eligibility and qualifications by submitting the documents listed below.

#### **Basic qualification (§ 74 ZZVZ)**

The economic operator shall demonstrate basic eligibility pursuant to Section 74 of the ZZVZ by submitting documents pursuant to Section 75(1) of the ZZVZ. (The economic operator may use the form in Annex 2 to these tender documents for the affirmation pursuant to Section 75(1)(c), (d), and (f). Section 86(2) of the ZZVZ shall not apply (basic eligibility cannot be replaced by an affirmation).

#### **Professional qualification (§ 77 ZZVZ)**

Economic operators are required to prove their professional qualification in accordance with the provisions of Section 77(1) of the ZZVZ by submitting the following documents:

1. a copy of an entry in the Commercial Register or other similar records provided that registration in such records is required pursuant to another legal regulation.

#### **Technical qualification (§ 79 ZZVZ)**

The economic operator shall prove that it complies with this qualification criterion in accordance with the provisions of Section 79(2)(c) and (d) of the ZZVZ by submitting:

1. a list of the persons (technicians) that will take part in the performance of the public contract, regardless of whether they are employees of the economic operator or persons otherwise related to the economic operator showing that the economic operator has an implementation team consisting of:
  - a) at least 1 person (Specialist for Energy Recovery from Waste) that has:
    - min. 8 years of experience in complex construction/delivery of projects in the power/thermal industry focused on waste incineration and waste incineration flue gas treatment and commissioning of these projects, from the design phase to the commissioning phase, having held a position in this specialization with min. 4 years;
    - min. 1 reference of construction/delivery of an incineration plant project with a capacity of at least 100 thousand tonnes/year, including its commissioning;
    - expertise in municipal waste incineration and waste incineration boiler technology and waste incineration flue gas cleaning;
    - experience in the areas of measurement, validation, cleaning of flue gas, knowledge of sampling and analysis; and
    - experience in the field of combustion and design of steam boilers for waste incineration in the energy/heating industry.

#### Method of proving compliance:

Submission of a list of persons forming the economic operator's implementation team, showing whether the persons concerned meet the requirements of the Contracting Authority.

This list must be accompanied by professional CVs signed by the persons concerned, containing at least the following information:

- name and surname of the person,
- employer identification,

- relationship to the economic operator (employment, subcontracting or other),
- designation of the position in the performance of the public contract,
- detailed information on the projects or experience required to be carried out by the persons concerned in accordance with point 1. above Technical qualification, in such detail as to enable the Contracting Authority to verify compliance with the required parameters, in particular in relation to the minimum experience required.

The CV must be accompanied by at least a copy of the required certificate, if one is required for the position (unless this certificate is already attached to demonstrate compliance with the professional qualification requirement above).

For the purpose of drawing up the list of the persons (technicians) that will take part in the performance of the public contract, the Contracting Authority recommends the economic operator to use the template of this list, which is attached as Annex No. 3 to this procurement documents, in order to make the qualification assessment process clearer and faster. Economic operators are free to add rows to the tables if necessary. The Contracting Authority requests economic operators to indicate for each person on the list whether that person belongs directly to the economic operator (e.g. as an employee), to which economic operator of the economic operators submitting a joint tender that person belongs, or to which subcontractor that person belongs.

#### **Authenticity of documents proving qualification**

Economic operators are required to prove their qualification. The economic operator shall prove their qualification in all cases by submitting relevant documents in simple copies of the originals (e.g., in scanned form).

In accordance with Section 45(1) of the ZZVZ, the contracting authority may, in accordance with the procedure laid down in Section 46(1) of the ZZVZ, require the submission of originals or officially certified copies of documents.

Qualification and eligibility may also be demonstrated by a European Single Procurement Document (in particular Section 87 of the ZZVZ) to the extent that the information contained therein covers the contracting authority's requirements. The economic operator is not obliged to submit to the contracting authority documents certifying the facts contained in the European Single Procurement Document if it informs the contracting authority in which other procurement procedure it has already submitted them.

Furthermore, qualification and eligibility may be demonstrated, to the extent that the recorded data covers the contracting authority's requirements, by an extract from the system of certified economic operators (in particular Section 234 of the ZZVZ), or an extract from the list of qualified economic operators (in particular Section 228 of the ZZVZ) or in accordance with Section 45(4) of the ZZVZ.

The economic operator is entitled to prove a certain part of the technical qualification or professional competence, with the exception of the criteria under Section 77(1) of the ZZVZ, through other persons in the manner specified in Section 83 of the ZZVZ. In such a case, the economic operator is obliged to submit to the contracting authority:

- i. documents proving the fulfillment of professional competence pursuant to Section 77(1) of the ZZVZ by another person
- ii. documents proving the fulfillment of the missing part of the qualification through another person,
- iii. documents proving the fulfillment of basic competence pursuant to Section 74 of the ZZVZ by another person, and

- iv. a contract or other confirmation signed by another person confirming its existence, the content of which is the commitment of another person to provide performance intended for the performance of a public contract or to provide items or rights that the contractor will be entitled to dispose of in the performance of a public contract, at least to the extent to which another person has proven the qualification for the contractor.

The requirement under point iv. of this paragraph shall be deemed to be met if the content of the contract or confirmation of its existence shows the commitment of another person to perform the public contract jointly and severally with the economic operator. However, if the economic operator proves its qualification through another person and submits documents pursuant to Section 79(2)(b) or (d) of the ZZVZ relating to that person, the document referred to in point (iv) of this paragraph must indicate the obligation that the other person will perform the services to which the proven qualification criterion relates.

The economic operator may use a written affirmation for another person in accordance with Annex No. 2 of the tender documentation (declaration of honor to prove basic eligibility).

A public contract may be performed by several economic operators jointly; in such a case, the economic operators shall submit a joint application for participation in accordance with, in particular, Section 82 of the ZZVZ. The contracting authority also requires that all economic operators submitting a joint application for participation bear joint and several liability for the performance of the public contract within the meaning of Section 103(1)(f) of the ZZVZ.

In the case of confirmations issued by a state administration body, this may be, for example, a confirmation that will be electronically signed and sent by that body to the economic operator's data box (in which case it will be sufficient to submit only this electronically signed file) or it may be the original paper document, which has been converted into electronic form through authorized conversion (for example, at one of the Czech POINT offices).

A scan of a document issued by a state administration authority is not considered an original in electronic form (even if it is subsequently electronically signed by the economic operator).

Documents proving basic eligibility under Section 74 of the ZZVZ must prove that the required eligibility criteria have been met no later than **three months before the date of commencement of the procurement procedure**.

## VI. METHOD OF EVALUATION OF TENDERS

**Evaluation criterion**                      **The basic evaluation criterion is, by analogy with Section 114(1) of the ZZVZ, the economic advantageousness of the tender.**

**The economic advantageousness of the tenders shall be evaluated on the basis of the following criteria and weightings, which represent the proportion of the individual evaluation criteria in the overall evaluation:**

**1. Sub-assessment criterion A: Tender price excluding VAT for works on the construction site**

This evaluation criterion is a quantitative criterion where lower values are preferred over higher values.

The evaluation shall be based on the tender price quoted by the economic operator excluding VAT within the meaning of Article VIII. of these procurement documents for works on the construction site.

The most advantageous tender, i.e. the tender with the lowest tender price relevant for this evaluation criterion among all the tenders evaluated, will be awarded 100 points. The other tenders will be awarded a point value determined by multiplying 100 by the ratio of the tender price relevant to this evaluation criterion submitted by the most advantageous tender (i.e. the lowest tender) to the tender price of the evaluated tender.

The score thus obtained will be multiplied by a coefficient of 0,42 (i.e. the weighting of the sub-assessment criterion) and then mathematically rounded to two decimal places.

The calculation corresponds to the following formula:

**Lowest tender price excluding VAT for works on the construction site x 100**

**0,42 x ----- = Number of points for criterion A.**

**Tender price excluding VAT for works on the construction site in the tender being evaluated**

**2. Sub-assessment criterion B: Tender price excluding VAT for works outside the construction site**

This evaluation criterion is a quantitative criterion where lower values are preferred over higher values.

The evaluation shall be based on the tender price quoted by the economic operator excluding VAT within the meaning of Article VIII. of these procurement documents for works outside the construction site.

The most advantageous tender, i.e. the tender with the lowest tender price relevant for this evaluation criterion among all the tenders evaluated, will be awarded 100 points. The other tenders will be awarded a point value determined by multiplying 100 by the ratio of the tender price relevant to this evaluation criterion submitted by the most advantageous tender (i.e. the lowest tender) to the tender price of the evaluated tender.

The score thus obtained will be multiplied by a coefficient of 0,28 (i.e. the weighting of the sub-assessment criterion) and then mathematically rounded to two decimal places.

The calculation corresponds to the following formula:

### **3. Sub-assessment criterion C: Qualification and experience of Specialist for Energy Recovery from Waste**

This evaluation criterion is a quantitative criterion where higher values are preferred over lower ones.

The subject of the evaluation shall be the qualification and experience of the member of the implementation team as Specialist for Energy Recovery from Waste as indicated by the economic operator.

Tenders will be awarded a point value determined by multiplying the number of points obtained by 100 times the ratio of the number of points obtained to 8 as the maximum number of points available.

The number of points thus obtained will be multiplied by a coefficient of 0,30 (i.e. the weighting of the sub-assessment criterion) and then mathematically rounded to two decimal places.

The calculation corresponds to the following formula:

### **4. Overall evaluation**

Rounding to two decimal places will be used in all numerical operations in the evaluation.

The overall final score will be calculated as the sum of the economic operator's points under sub-assessment criterion A: Tender price excluding VAT for works on the construction site, the economic operator's points under sub-assessment criterion B: Tender price excluding VAT for works outside the construction site and the economic operator's points under sub-assessment criterion C: Qualification and experience of Specialist for Energy Recovery from Waste.

The most economically advantageous tender shall be the tender with the highest total number of points.

## VII. MODEL CONTRACT

**The contract must be submitted together with its annexes, which must be complete and include a description of individual items. The contract does not have to be signed by a person authorized to represent the economic operator in the economic operators tender.**

In accordance with Section 104(e) of the ZZVZ and Section 122(3)(b) of the ZZVZ, the selected economic operator is obliged to send the contracting authority, upon request, the original signed draft contract, including all annexes, in electronic form, bearing the electronic signature of an authorized person. If the selected economic operator fails to do so, the contracting authority reserves the right to exclude them in accordance with Section 122(8) of the ZZVZ.

If the authorization of the person to act on behalf of the economic operator is not evident from the documents proving their qualification, the tender shall include proof of such authorization.

The terms and conditions are an integral part of this tender documentation and are incorporated into the text of the contract and are binding on the economic operator. The economic operator is obliged to base the contract on the terms and conditions; the economic operator is not entitled to change or add any information or provisions when drafting contracts, except for information which, based on its content, must be supplemented (marked as "[TO BE FILLED BY THE ECONOMIC OPERATOR]").

## VIII. REQUIREMENTS FOR THE TENDER PRICE

For the purposes of the procurement procedure, the tender price means the total estimated price for the performance of the subject of the public contract, excluding value added tax, as set out in the table for the preparation of the tender price completed by the economic operator, which forms Annex No. 7 to these procurement documents.

The economic operator is responsible for the correct determination of the VAT rate.

The tender price will always be broken down as follows:

- a) the tender price excluding VAT;
- b) the VAT rate;
- c) the tender price including VAT.

The economic operator is obliged to indicate the tender price in the completed price table attached as Annex No. 7 to this procurement documents.

The total tender price will be fixed and complete and will include all the performance required to fulfil the subject-matter of the public contract. After the conclusion of the contract, the price for the performance may be changed only on the basis of the rules laid down in the contract or in accordance with the procedure laid down by law, in particular the ZZVZ.

For the avoidance of doubt, the Contracting Authority states that the number of units (hours) for the estimated scope of performance set out in Annex No. 7 to this procurement documents is an

estimated number, set out in a model for the purposes of evaluating tenders, and is not binding for the performance of the subject-matter of the public contract.

## IX. TENDER CONTENTS

The contracting authority recommends that the tender contain the following:

1. Economic operator identification data specified in the "**Tender cover sheet**" form (business name, name or first and last name; registered office or place of business; identification number. In the case of a joint tender: (company pursuant to Section 2716 et seq. of the Civil Code): Company name; identification details of company members, method of acting on behalf of the company) – the form is attached as Annex No. 1.
2. Documents proving qualification.
3. Document authorizing the person who will sign the contracts to conclude the contract with the contracting authority.
4. Contract, including all annexes, which does not need to be signed by the economic operator.
5. Table with the tender price filled in, for which the economic operator shall use Annex No. 7 to this tender documentation.
6. Filled in tender evaluation table with relevant experience of the implementation team member, for which the economic operator shall use Annex No. 9 to this tender documentation.
7. Affirmation pursuant to EU Council Regulation No. 2022/576 in relation to sanctions against Russia, a template for which is provided in Annex No. 5.
8. Affirmation of the economic operator regarding the absence of a conflict of interest, for which the economic operator shall use Annex No. 6 of this tender documentation.
9. Other documents required in the tender conditions or on the basis thereof.

## X. TENDER SUBMISSION

Tenders shall be submitted exclusively in electronic form via the electronic tool specified in Article IV of these tender documents. The tender does not need to be signed with an electronic signature by an authorized person of the economic operator.

Time limit: **by 7<sup>th</sup> April 2026 09:00 hrs.**

Place and method: Tenders must be submitted no later than the time limit for submission of tenders specified above.

## XI. OPENING OF TENDERS

Tenders in electronic form will be opened after the time limit for submission of tenders under the conditions set out in Section 109 of the ZZVZ. The opening of electronic tenders is not public.

## XII. EXPLANATION AND ALTERATION OF PROCUREMENT DOCUMENTS

Although these procurement documents define the subject-matter of the public contract in sufficient detail for the preparation of tenders, economic operators may request clarification of the procurement conditions.

The Contracting Authority notes that all communication with the Contracting Authority in the context of the procurement procedure for this public contract must be conducted electronically, in particular via an electronic tool.

In accordance with Section 98(3) of the ZZVZ, the economic operator is entitled to request clarification of the procurement documents from the Contracting Authority. A written request must be delivered to the Contracting Authority **no later than 8 working days** before the expiry of the deadline for submitting objections set out in Section 242(5) of the ZZVZ; the Contracting Authority is not obliged to respond to requests delivered later in accordance with the ZZVZ. The Contracting Authority shall send an explanation of the procurement documents for this public contract, or related documents, no later than within 3 working days after receipt of the economic operator's written request.

In accordance with Section 98(1) of the ZZVZ, the Contracting Authority may provide suppliers with an explanation of the procurement documents even without a prior request.

## XIII. OTHER REQUIREMENTS

In accordance with Section 122(5) of the ZZVZ, the contracting authority shall ascertain from the selected economic operator, if it is a Czech legal entity, information about its beneficial owner in accordance with the law governing the register of beneficial owners from the register of beneficial owners under the same law (hereinafter referred to as the "**register of beneficial owners**").

In accordance with Section 122(8) of the ZZVZ, the contracting authority shall exclude the selected economic operator, if it is a Czech legal entity that has a beneficial owner, if it was not possible to ascertain information about its beneficial owner from the register of beneficial owners pursuant to Section 122(5) of the ZZVZ; the entry made available in the register of beneficial owners after the notification of the contractor's exclusion has been sent shall not be taken into account.

Tenders containing variants are not permitted.

The contracting authority only accepts tenders in Czech or Slovak, and also accepts university diplomas in Latin.

**If there is only one economic operator in the tender procedure, the contracting authority is not obliged under Section 50 of the ZZVZ to send this economic operator a notification of the selection of the economic operator.**

The contracting authority reserves the right to announce its decision to exclude a economic operator by publishing the decision on the contracting authority's profile; the decision to exclude a economic operator is then considered delivered at the moment of publication on the contracting authority's profile.

The contracting authority reserves the right to change, supplement, or clarify the tender conditions during the tender submission period.

The economic operator is not entitled to reimbursement of costs associated with participation in the tender procedure. The contracting authority will not reimburse any expenses or losses that may be

incurred by economic operators in connection with any aspects of the tender procedure, except as provided for in Section 40(6) of the ZZVZ.

**In accordance with Section 242(5) of the ZZVZ, the contracting authority stipulates that objections to the tender conditions may be submitted no later than 72 hours before the end of the deadline for submitting tenders.**

The Contracting Authority is, in accordance with the provisions of Section 100(2) of the ZZVZ and Section 222(10) of the ZZVZ, entitled to conclude a new contract with another economic operator (a economic operator in the procurement procedure) for the public contract under the conditions set out below:

- a) In the event of unilateral termination of the contract concluded with the selected economic operator, the Contracting Authority is entitled to conclude a new contract with the economic operator in the public procurement procedure who, according to the result of the evaluation, is ranked behind the economic operator with whom the contract was originally concluded (i.e. in the original evaluation of the public contract), provided that such (new) economic operator agrees to provide the performance of the public contract under the terms and conditions contained in its tender submitted in the public procurement procedure and in the procurement documents for the public contract within the meaning of Section 28(1)(b) of the ZZVZ.
- b) If the economic operator approached by the Contracting Authority to conclude a new contract refuses to conclude a new contract with the Contracting Authority and thus provide performance in place of the originally selected economic operator, the Contracting Authority shall be entitled to turn to the third-ranked economic operator.

In the event that any of the conditions of the reserved change under Article XIII.(a) of these procurement documents are fulfilled under the newly concluded contract(s) with a new economic operator, the Contracting Authority shall be entitled to conclude a new contract with the next economic operator in the sequence, subject to the above conditions under Article XIII.(a) and (b) of these procurement documents.

#### **XIV. SOCIALLY RESPONSIBLE PUBLIC PROCUREMENT**

The Contracting Authority is interested in awarding the public contract in accordance with the principles of socially responsible public procurement (hereinafter referred to as "SRPP"). In addition to the emphasis on purely economic parameters, the SRPP also takes into account the related impacts of the public contract, in particular in the areas of employment, social and labour rights and the environment.

The Contracting Authority will require the selected economic operator to ensure compliance with labour law regulations (Labour Code and Employment Act) and the obligations arising therefrom, in particular in relation to remuneration of employees, working time, rest periods, employment of foreigners and compliance with occupational health and safety conditions for all persons involved in the performance of the subject of the public contract. At the same time, the contracting authority will require proper and timely fulfilment of financial obligations to all economic operators in the supply chain involved in the performance of the contract.

In the context of the SRPP, the economic operator is required to include in its tender a written affirmation on the implementation of the SRPP core measures for the purposes of the performance of the public contract. For this purpose, the economic operator shall use Annex No. 8 to these procurement documents as a template.
